Dear Parent (I to IX),

Warm greetings to you! “Together may we give children the roots, to grow and the wings to fly”. We record our earnest note of thanks for all the support you have been extending. We would like to inform you on noteworthy updates during the months of June and July 2019.

1. New initiatives have been introduced for improving the language of students. We have allotted 15 minutes every day for framing sentences. As part of the timetable, students from Grades III to IX have one period each for Public Presentation, Essay writing and Spoken English to improve communication skills of the students. Booklets are issued for the same from Grades III to IX.
2. Hand writing period is introduced for students of Grades I to VIII. Separate Handwriting books were issued to students of Grade from I to VIII to improve their Handwriting.
3. Classroom library is created for grades I – III to promote reading. You are encouraged to borrow books from school library on Saturday evenings in your ward’s name. When your ward sees you reading a book, he/she will inturn do so.
4. Please encourage your ward to practice Maths at www.vallaba.in/infy and read stories online at www.vallaba.in/reader.
5. Students of Grades V to IX periodically take up assessments (objective questions) offered by External assessment companies. Open Door conducts it for Grades V & VI. Detailed Assessment conducts it for Grades VII to IX. The results of the assessments will be made available to you within 2 or 3 days of the exam.
6. Guides would call you on a random basis to get feedback about your ward’s needs. We request you to be transparent in sharing your views for mutual benefit.
7. Some of you have requested for Saturday holiday or half working day. Due to the introduction of various new initiatives, we may not be able to do so for all Saturdays. Kindly cooperate with us in this regard.
8. If you are interested to do story telling sessions for students, please send a letter through your ward to the class teacher.
9. Compared to previous years, this year we have planned to participate in many Inter-school competitions. Your co-operation is solicited.
